Don't pay for the promise of a job.



Remember...

Scammers advertise jobs the same way honest employers do

Scammers place ads on job websites and social media, in newspapers, and sometimes on TV and radio. But what they want is your money or personal information.

Don't pay for a promise

Scammers may say they've got a job waiting — or that they'll guarantee you a job — if you pay a fee. But honest employers won't ask you to pay for the promise of a job.

Never bank on a "cleared" check

Honest employers won't send you a check and tell you to send on part of the money, or to buy gift cards with it.
That's a scam. The check will bounce and the bank will want you to repay the money.
